#### Notes:

- 2. Out-of-province cases are excluded.
- 3. The diseases where the current monthly rates are significantly higher than the previous 3-year average rates for the same month are highlighted yellow.
- 4. Hepatitis B: This includes confirmed cases of acute infection only, where both surface antigen (HBsAG) and core antibody (Anti-HBc IgM) are positive.
- 5. Since the reportable diseases' list was updated in January 2015, this monthly report was correspondingly modified.
- 6. The two categories "ARO and Nosocomial Organisms" and "Non VPD" have been combined to the category "Other diseases" since Jan 2015.
