#### **Notes and Abbreviations**

#### Notes:

- 1. 3-year-average cases / rate are defined as the average cases / rate reported in the same month over the previous three years.
- 2. Out-of-province cases are excluded.
- 3. The diseases where the current monthly rates are significantly higher than the previous 3-year average rates for the same month are highlighted vellow.
- 4. Syphilis: Due to improved testing and referral processes that took place in 2013, there was an observed increase in the number of records entered into the surveillance system. The data point shown in the table includes all reported Treponema serology-reactive individuals, however these may be infectious and non-infectious cases, as well as those requiring further public health follow-up to determine this status. These factors also make it difficult to draw a comparison to historical data, therefore statistical testing was not done.
- 5. Hepatitis B: This includes confirmed cases of acute infection only, where both surface antigen (HBsAG) and core antibody (Anti-HBc IgM) are positive.
- 6. Since the reportable diseases' list was updated in January 2015, this monthly report was correspondingly modified.
- 7. The two categories "ARO and Nosocomial Organisms" and "Non VPD" have been combined to the category "Other diseases" since Jan 2015.
