INFLUENZA IN MANITOBA - 2009/2010 SEASON

Report on Cases reported up to 4:00 PM, December 12th, 2009

The following report details influenza activity in Manitoba from the start of the 2009/2010 flu season, which runs from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010. The public health disease surveillance system of Manitoba Health and Healthy Living received its first laboratory-confirmed positive case of influenza for the season during the week of July 1 to July 4, 2009. This season there have been **1849** laboratory-confirmed cases of Influenza A, of which **1823** were laboratory-confirmed cases of pandemic H1N1 (pH1N1), and **0** labconfirmed cases of Influenza B in the province.

LABORATORY-CONFIRMED INFLUENZA

- Reports from Cadham Provincial Laboratory (CPL) are forwarded to the public health disease surveillance system of Manitoba Health and Healthy Living weekly.
- The number of positive cultures is an underestimate of the total number of cases, since not all persons with influenza seek medical attention, and of those that do, not all are cultured for the virus.
- Information contained within this update is based on positive lab reports confirmed on or before **December 12th, 2009**. The date the laboratory specimen is taken is used to assign cases to the appropriate week/month.

<u>INFLUENZA A</u>

- There have been 1849 cases of Influenza A reported this season in Manitoba. Increased testing is occurring probably related to an increased awareness of pH1N1. This has resulted in an expected increase of Influenza A case finding.

INFLUENZA B

- There have been **0** cases of Influenza B reported this season in Manitoba.

REPORTS OF INFLUENZA-LIKE ILLNESS OUTBREAKS

ILI outbreaks are defined as:

Schools and work sites: greater than 10% absenteeism on any day most likely due to ILI

Residential institutions: two or more cases of ILI within a seven-day period, including at least one laboratory confirmed case.

- These outbreaks of influenza must be accompanied by a positive influenza lab report to be counted. The outbreak-related cases reflected on tables and figures within this report are lab confirmed. Most outbreak-related cases are not lab confirmed.
- As of **December 12th**, **2009**, there was one regional outbreak of lab confirmed Influenza A reported to the public health disease surveillance system for the 2009-2010 season (a school in Parkland). No outbreaks of Influenza B have been reported.

This report uses the specimen collection date to assign cases to the appropriate week/month. This may not reflect other current statistics, which frequently use the date the disease was lab-confirmed to assign cases. The report date is always later than the specimen date, which will create inconsistencies between reports in the number of cases assigned to each week/month in question.






Figure 3: Laboratory-Confirmed Cases of Influenza A pH1N1 Only, 2008/2009-2009/2010
