

Manitoba needs you to do your part to prevent the spread of zebra mussels in your community!



How you can help:

CLEAN and remove aquatic invasive species (AIS) and aquatic plants before leaving the shore of the water body.

DRAIN all water from the watercraft and water-related equipment before leaving the shore.

DRY watercraft and water-related equipment completely before placing it into another water body.

DECONTAMINATE if watercraft and water-related equipment were used last in a provincially-designated control zone and before placing into another water body.

Did you know?

A single adult zebra mussel offspring can't be seen to the naked eye, but can easily cling to your boat or water equipment when moving from one water body to another.
